GIRLS UNWANTED

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SCENE 1

A halfway house.

In the inner city. Nothing fancy. The living room and part of the kitchen. An old dining table just outside the kitchen

Kat and Hanna enter from the kitchen. Arguing. They are both in their late teens. Kat is lean and tough and dressed in jeans and a t-shit. Hanna is messy-haired and wearing an over sized t-shirt.

KAT

You have to shut up! I'm telling you, if you don't keep your stupid mouth closed, I'm gonna hurt you!

HANNA Yeah there's the tough talk! Calm down, okay. You're way too worked up.

KAT

I'm worked up? Who's the one that's been whining about her fucking breakfast for the last ten minutes?

HANNA

That wasn't breakfast. It was a bowl of cereal. Breakfast is eggs or waffles.

KAT Waffles? What's your fucking problem...

HANNA

I'm just saying, if I'd wanted a lousy bowl of cereal I could have made it myself.

KAT Yeah, but then you wouldn't have anything to complain about.

HANNA Except you and your nasty mouth you mean. Fucking this. Fucking that. (MORE)

HANNA (CONT'D) How long do I have to listen to that garbage? KAT Until I fucking kill you, I guess! Kat pushes her. HANNA Knock it off. KAT Sure... She pushes her again. HANNA I mean it, Kat. KAT "I mean it, Kat." (pushes her) Idiot. What is it with all your bullshit anyway! Everything's always wrong for you. You don't like your breakfast. You don't like your room. Then there's that crap you keep feeding us about being abused... HANNA I was abused. KAT Oh please fuck off! HANNA I was abandoned. And that's a kind of abuse. KAT You were "abandoned" in a house with an in-ground pool. HANNA What's it matter about the pool? I was still abandoned. And left alone with a brother who... did stuff. KAT What kind of stuff?

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HANNA

Stuff I'm not ready to talk about!

KAT

Yeah, because you haven't finished making it up!

HANNA

What about you? Your nasty mouth. All the garbage you leave lying around. When's the last time you washed a dish or swept a floor? You think that's not bullshit behaviour? And sneaking out at night looking for random guys to bang. What's that about?

KAT

Sex. It's about sex, Hanna.

HANNA

Yeah, well I have nightmares about it.

KAT You have nightmares about me getting laid.

HANNA

No. About you bringing some guy back here who rapes and murders us all.

KAT

Really?

HANNA

Yes!

KAT

Okay. Except in your case, he'd probably skip the rape and get right to the murder just to shut you the fuck up.

HANNA

That's just ugly, Kat. That shows what kind of monster you really are.

KAT

Fuck off.

HANNA

No you fuck off, you nasty bitch. That's all you are, you know. Some nasty moody bitch who likes to bang strangers.

KAT

Yeah. Bang strangers. And beat the crap out of fat girls.

Kat goes for Hanna's throat. They struggle, both trying to throw punches. Kat is better at it. But Hanna manges to land a kick to Kat's groin.

HANNA

I'm not fat, you druggie skank!

Kat recovers, puts Hanna down and starts to bang her head on the floor.

HANNA (CONT'D) Stop it. You're hurting me! Kat!! Please!!

Kat stops. Gets off her. Leans back against the couch. Looks at Hanna who is whimpering and rubbing her head.

KAT I really hurt you, eh?

HANNA Yeah. You did.

KAT (mumbles) More bullshit.

HANNA

What?

KAT I said I'm sorry.

HANNA (looks at her) Are you? KAT Kinda. HANNA Kinda. God. What's wrong with you? KAT (mumbles) I don't know. HANNA What? KAT What's wrong with you? Hanna just looks at her.

They both mutter something nasty to themselves.

Blackout

SCENE 2

Hanna is on the couch with a bag of frozen peas on her head, looking at Max who is standing at the entrance to the living room.

HANNA

Hi...

MAX

Hi...

HANNA You looking for someone?

MAX Yeah. Katherine. I mean... Kat.

HANNA

I'm Kat.

MAX Really? No, I mean this Kat.

He takes a small photo out of his pocket. Holds it up.

HANNA Let me see that.

He hands her the photo.

HANNA (CONT'D) Yeah this is Kat all right.

MAX The other Kat.

HANNA

There is no other Kat. I was just messing with you. It's a mug shot. Where'd you get this?

MAX I found this social worker who has a policeman friend and he--

HANNA What do you want with her? Are you a friend. MAX No, not really.

HANNA

Right, so you're just someone she screwed. And now you want another piece of that bony little ass of hers?

MAX

No. Look, is she here?

HANNA Yeah. She's up in her room.

MAX Well can you ask her to come down?

> HANNA But she won't do t

Sure. But she won't do that unless I tell her who you are.

MAX

It's private.

HANNA

What is?

MAX

Who I am. What I want. That's all private. So can you just go get her.

HANNA Maybe. If you stop being so pushy.

MAX Right. Sorry. Please. Could you please just get her for me?

HANNA

That's better.

She jumps up. Goes to hallway.

HANNA (CONT'D) Kat! Get down here. You've got a visitor!! (looks at Max) It might take her awhile. She's having a little trouble walking. MAX What's wrong with her?

HANNA She got kicked in the cooch. (off his look) You know... (gestures to her groin) The pink, the poontang, the tunnel of love... Don't think there's any permanent damage, so if it really is a little action you're looking for--

MAX It's not.

HANNA

Well whatever. Have to get these peas back in the freezer for awhile so...

She heads towards the kitchen.

HANNA (CONT'D) You want a beverage of some kind?

MAX No I'm okay.

HANNA We got water, lemonade and... maybe a coke or something. (entering kitchen) Let me know if you change your mind.

Max just stands there, looking around.

Kat comes in, a slight limp. Looks at Max.

KAT You looking for me?

MAX

Yeah...

KAT Do I know you? You look familiar.

MAX I do? KAT A little, yeah. Have we... spent time together? I mean I mighta been high, and I can't always remember --MAX No I'm not someone you-- We've never met. KAT Okay. So whatya want? MAX Yeah. Well I was talking to Ms Able and she--KAT Ms Able. MAX Yeah. She said she was your social worker awhile ago. But you might not remember her. KAT Because? MAX Because most of the time you were kinda strung out. KAT Yeah? Well fuck her. I remember that snarky bitch just fine. So you were talking to her about ...? MAX Our situation. KAT We've got a situation? MAX Yeah. And she said it might be good for you if I made contact. And

that's what I wanted to do anyway so--

KAT Dude, what the fuck are you talking about? MAX (smiles) I'm your brother. Kat just looks at him. Hanna sticks her head out from the kitchen. HANNA What was that he just said? KAT He said he's... (looks hard at Max) My brother. HANNA No shit. You told everyone you were given up at birth. (to Max) That's the only personal thing she's ever told us. I thought she might have been lying. She lies a lot. KAT Go away, Hanna. Hanna ignores her. HANNA (to Max) Unless you meant you're a foster brother. KAT (to Max) Yeah. I knew I recognized you from somewhere. You were at Nicki's house on Delaware, right. That was like almost ten years ago. MAX No... KAT Earlier?

MAX No. I'm not one of your foster brothers. I'm your real brother. We have the same parents. KAT (just looks at him) ... I don't have parents. MAX Yeah. You do. We both do. And they're the same people. HANNA What's your name? (off Kat's look) I thought someone should ask. MAX (to Kat) My names's Max. KAT Max. And you're my brother? Really? MAX Yeah... Kat sits. HANNA How about that. So who's the one that's really all alone in the world now, eh? Me! (back into kitchen) Just me! KAT (to Max) So did they give you up too? MAX No. They... kept me. KAT They kept you. Jesus. Why? HANNA (sticks her head out) Because he's a boy, you idiot.

MAX No it wasn't that. (to Kat) They just got back together. I mean after they let you go, they got together again and they--KAT Had you. MAX Yeah... KAT And they kept you. MAX Well they were a little older. And they were ready to start a family then, so--KAT Start a family. MAX Yeah... HANNA (sticks her head out) And she couldn't be part of that family for some reason? KAT (to Max) What she said. MAX You'd been adopted, and they couldn't find out where you--KAT That didn't work out by the way. The adoption thing. I left that happy home when I was twelve. MAX Yeah. They found that out. But no

one knew where you'd gone.

KAT

Yeah I made sure of that. If they find you, they sometimes send you back to the place you ran away from.

HANNA

(from the kitchen) And there was no way she was going back to those *awful* people. (sticks her head out)

They only adopted her so they'd have someone to clean their house. That's her story anyway. I think it's just one of her ugly lies.

KAT

(to Max) It's true.

MAX

Jeez. Okay... Well they tried. Our parents, I mean. They tried really hard to find you.

KAT

They tried. And then they just gave up.

MAX Well the thing is, Mum has some problems.

KAT What kind of problems.

MAX

She has depression. It's pretty bad, so dealing with that took over everything for them.

KAT For them. But not for you. You kept looking.

MAX

Yeah... and people like Ms Able felt sorry for me because I was still a kid when I started. Just twelve... and they bent some rules for me and--

KAT You've been looking for me for--MAX Four years. Off and on. I mean I had to go to school, right. KAT Sure. But here you are. And... What? MAX You mean what now? Like what do I want to happen? KAT Yeah. You got something in mind? MAX I... just wanted to meet you. And then maybe take it from there. KAT Take it where? MAX Well that's--KAT What's your name? MAX Max. KAT Yeah I got that part. Your whole name. MAX Harvey. Max Harvey KAT Harvey's a first name. MAX (smiles) Except when it isn't, I guess.

KAT Right. So are you the only one? (off his look) The only kid they had after me.

MAX

No. I had a younger sister. Leanne. She died of leukemia.

KAT

Leukemia.

MAX Yeah it's a kind of--

KAT I know what it is. When did that happen?

MAX She was eleven. She was a great kid. You would have liked her. Everyone liked her. We miss her a lot.

KAT Right. So is that why you're here? You think I'd be a good replacement for her or something.

MAX No. Well maybe... in a way. I know it would mean a lot if I could bring you together with my... our parents. But mostly I'm here

because I thought we could get to know each other and then--

KAT

Sure. Let's do that. Let's get to know each other. Here's my life story. You know, just to get us started. I was given up at birth. I was adopted. I was molested. I ran away.

MAX

What?

KAT I ran away. MAX No. Before that...

KAT Yeah before that, I was molested.

MAX Molested. In the same place where they made you clean?

HANNA (from kitchen) A little hard to believe, isn't it.

KAT (to Max) Wait until you hear *her* story. So should I keep going or have you heard enough?

HANNA (from kitchen) I have!

Hanna steps out of the kitchen with a large sandwich she has made.

HANNA (CONT'D) I'm going to my room. Unless you're all of a sudden going to start telling the truth. That'd be worth hanging around for.

KAT

Eat me.

HANNA (leaving) That's never gonna happen.

Hanna is gone

KAT

KAT (CONT'D)

Got arrested. Did two years in detention. Got out. More time on the street. More drugs. More stealing shit. More time inside but with a rougher crowd. Got beat up. Got rescued and put in here. I turned eighteen last month so now I'm an adult. Kinda. And soon they'll be letting me go out there on my own. Any questions?

MAX

What about school?

KAT Yeah I went sometimes.

MAX

Just sometimes?

KAT

Well who the fuck can listen to all that crap five days a week.

MAX

Yeah that's kinda my problem too. I just do it because--

KAT

Hey this is about me. You'll get your turn. Okay where was I?

MAX

School. You weren't there much.

KAT

No. But I was still doing okay. Not great. But good enough to pass. Then one day my gym teacher got the idea that a little verbal abuse might motivate me more. She was right. It motivated me to break her face.

MAX Break her face?

KAT Her jaw. I'd already had a bunch fights with other kids, so after the thing with the teacher they decided I needed to be put in a special place for students who were "Prone to Violence." The special place was a storage closet they'd cleared out for us near the boiler room. Me two other potential serial killers and a part time teacher who looked like a prison guard spent all day there learning to be "patient." MAX All day, all year? KAT Until I fucked off for good. (looks at him) Okay go ahead. MAX What? KAT It's your turn. MAX Oh. Well I'm--KAT Normal. Right. MAX Well not totally. But-- So are you still...? KAT Violent? Yeah I still get a little worked up sometimes. HANNA (entering) Sometimes like every second day.

Hanna goes back into the kitchen.

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KAT Time for another snack? (to Max) What are their names? The parents. MAX Julia and Tom. KAT Julia and Tom Harvey. Okay. And what are they like? MAX What do you mean? KAT I mean do they keep their hands off you? Is there food in the fridge? Is the house heated? Do you actually live in a house or in a box in a field or--MAX No. Yeah. We live in a small house. There's food. All that's okay, but... KAT What? MAX Well like I told ya, Mum's sick. She hears things. KAT You said she's depressed. MAX She's depressed, and she hears things. KAT And what about Tom Harvey? Does he hear things too? MAX No. But he's been in jail. KAT Really.

MAX

Twice.

KAT

For what?

MAX

Both times for fraud. Second time was the worst. Because that's when Leanne got sick, and me and my mum had to deal with that all on our own, and it was kinda--

KAT

Hard.

MAX Hard. And scary.

KAT

Yeah... Well you really lucked out with this family thing, eh. Maybe I shouldn't be so bitter about being given up. Okay, you gotta go now. I need to think about this.

MAX

Sure. But--

KAT No. Just go. Come back tomorrow. Or maybe next week is better. Okay?

MAX What? Next week?

KAT Yeah... if you can. If you still want to.

MAX Yeah. Sure that'd be... (starts out, stops) Aren't you supervised here. Ms Able told me this a halfway house.

KAT That's what they call it, yeah.

MAX And you're on your own? KAT No. We've got Maddy. She's our... guardian. Any more questions?

MAX

No... (he starts out) No...

He leaves.

HANNA (leaving kitchen) She called awhile ago. Maddy. (approaching) She wanted us to be prepared.

KAT

For what?

HANNA She's bringing Ash back.

KAT Yeah? Is she on her meds?

HANNA

I didn't ask.

KAT

So how are we supposed to prepare then? Ash on her meds, Ash *off* her meds, not really the same thing, is it?

HANNA (gesturing to door) He seems nice.

KAT

So what?

HANNA

Well if you're gonna have a brother it's better if it's someone who's kinda normal. My brother's a creep and a bully, and my parents let him do anything he wanted to me because he was their favourite.

KAT Because he wasn't overweight? HANNA You think that's funny. I could show you the scars I got from what he did. KAT Go ahead. HANNA I will. KAT When? HANNA When I feel like it. KAT Which means never. HANNA I've got scars, Kat. KAT Really? Like this one? She lifts her t-shirt to reveal a long scar on her abdomen. HANNA Don't pull that shit. That's from getting your appendix out or something. KAT Something like a knife with a sixinch blade. HANNA Jesus... I mean is that true? KAT Why the fuck would I lie about it? HANNA I don't know. Why do you lie about other things.

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KAT They're not lies, idiot. HANNA They sound like lies to me. KAT That's because they're about things you've never experienced. Why do you lie about your brother doing things to you. HANNA I don't. KAT Okay. HANNA I said I don't! KAT And I said okay! HANNA I mean really!! KAT Okay!! Really! Jesus! HANNA My head hurts. I might have internal bleeding. KAT Well that should get you extra attention. HANNA Which I might actually need! How's your lady part. KAT Almost as good as new. HANNA Think you'll be hitting the streets tonight to try it out? KAT That's the plan.

Kat is leaving, trying to compensate for her limp. Hanna watches her go.

Slut.	HANNA
Idiot	KAT

Blackout

SCENE 3 Maddy (late 20s) and Ash, 17 (sullen and in a hoodie) are in the living room. MADDY (yelling upstairs) Okay, you guys. I need you downstairs! KAT (off) I'm busy! HANNA (off) So am I! MADDY Well whatever you're both doing can wait. Get down here now! (to Ash) You okay? You look a little... Ash? ASH What? MADDY What's wrong with you? ASH Can I go to my room? MADDY Yeah as soon as we all have a little--Kat enters. KAT (to Ash) Hey, Babe. I missed you. (hugs her) How are ya? (no response) Ash? ASH What?

Hanna enters. HANNA Well look who it is. (to Maddy) What's wrong with her? MADDY I think she just needs to lie down. HANNA Isn't that all she's been doing for the last month? (to Ash) That hospital keep you on a treadmill or something? MADDY What? HANNA Well I don't know what her therapy was. Coulda been anything. KAT Except a fucking treadmill. (to Maddy) What's happening? MADDY We're having a meeting. There's some stuff we need to talk about. HANNA Like what? MADDY Well first off, there's a lot of work around here that's not getting done. HANNA (off Kat) By her, you mean. KAT I do my share. HANNA Her share is whatever's done when

Her share is whatever's done when she feels like stopping. (MORE)

HANNA (CONT'D) The bathroom hasn't been cleaned in a month. KAT I did it last week. MADDY Yeah? Well you did a lousy job. HANNA Right. Plus there's all that garbage still on the back porch. KAT (off Hanna) That's her "task". HANNA I never agreed to that. It was supposed to be up to Ash. I mean before she... MADDY Right. Ash... now that you're back, maybe you can... (no response) Hey. I'm talking to you, okay. ASH (looks around) Where's Victor? MADDY He's not here right now. KAT We think he mighta quit. ASH Why? HANNA Because of you. MADDY We don't know that. HANNA

She bit him, didn't she. She bit him on the wrist, and the man quit.

What a pussy, eh. HANNA He was worried she gave him Hep C. ASH Why? HANNA Because no one knows what you're up to when you disappear. What you take. Who you fuck. ASH Who I fuck? MADDY Do you remember doing that, honey? ASH Fucking someone? MADDY No. Biting Victor. ASH No. MADDY Well that's probably because you'd stopped taking your medication. ASH Yeah, maybe. Did I bite anyone else? Did I bite you, Hanna? HANNA Are you kidding? When I see that freaky look in your eyes I don't go anywhere near you. MADDY Okay, that's enough. HANNA

I'm just saying she looks like a vampire sometimes. And not a normal one either. More like a vampire/ zombie cross.

KAT

MADDY I said that's enough!

KAT

(to Hanna) Yeah shut up.

MADDY

(to Ash) It wasn't because you bit him. Victor just needed a break.

ASH Oh. So who's in charge?

MADDY I am. For awhile, anyway.

ASH Aren't you too young?

HANNA

(to Maddy) Yeah. Maybe you don't have enough experience. Some of us have serious problems, you know.

KAT

(to Maddy) She means her. She thinks she's actually the only one here who has "serious problems."

HANNA

No. I know Ash is actually very messed up. But all *you* need to do is stop sucking so much cock.

KAT Oh. That's my cure, is it?

HANNA

Well it might give you some self respect. And then you can get the hell out of here and leave the rest of us to our healing process.

KAT

Jesus, man. You're too much. Your "healing process?"

MADDY

She's not doing anything to get in the way of that, Hanna. If you want, you and I could talk alone more.

HANNA Didn't we just establish that you're not qualified.

MADDY I have a degree in social work. Just like Victor does.

HANNA

So what?

KAT She thinks you don't have the right kind of life experience.

MADDY (to Hanna) Is that right?

HANNA Yeah, kinda.

MADDY

Ten years ago I was just out of Juvie. I was an addict, a thief, a total fuck up.

KAT

Just like me.

HANNA

(to Maddy) You were in Juvie. And you were an addict. Is that true?

MADDY

Why, do you think I'm just trying to impress you?

HANNA

I just meant... why didn't you tell me all that before?

MADDY You mean show you my resume.

KAT (to Hanna) The point is, she's totally qualified to deal with us. Okay, Chubby? MADDY Kat... KAT Come on. It's just a nickname. (to Hanna) You know, like slut. ASH Or retard. MADDY Nobody here calls you retard. ASH Not to my face you mean. KAT I never do. HANNA And I only do it when you make me mad. KAT And how does she do that? HANNA By doing something retarded. MADDY Okay, enough! Let's all just--HANNA Like giving our food to the raccoons. KAT (to Ash) I don't mind that. But you should probably stop feeding the rats. ASH

Why? You don't think they get hungry?

HANNA

They're rats! Look just stop all that shit. Don't give our food to anything. Rats. Raccoons. Skunks.

MADDY

(to Ash) Skunks? You feed skunks?

ASH

Just one.

HANNA Yeah. I saw her doing it. (to Ash) Getting close up to that thing. Feeding it out of your hand. Suppose you get sprayed and bring that smell into the house.

ASH It's a pet. It would never--

MADDY What do you mean it's a pet, Ash?

HANNA

Who gives a flying fuck what she means!? I'm serious, Ash! If I see you giving our food out to any kind of freakin' animal again, I'm gonna get really upset.

ASH

Why?

KAT

Because it's food. And food's her only reason for living.

MADDY

Okay. No more of this. No matter how heated the situation gets, we knock it off with the stupid insults, okay.

HANNA Even on Twitter?

MADDY You're not allowed on Twitter.

KAT Since when? MADDY Since forever. KAT Oh. I guess I forgot. HANNA She goes on it all the time to make fun of me to her foster friends. MADDY How do you know that? HANNA I follow her. ASH Into the computer room? HANNA Jesus... (to Maddy) I follow her on Twitter. KAT And that's the only reason I tweet about her. HANNA You mean to piss me off. You're sick, Kat. KAT Well at least I only take up a normal amount of space. MADDY Jesus. What's all this about her weight all of a sudden? KAT You don't think she's kinda gross?

HANNA Everyone looks fat to druggies.

KAT (off Ash and Maddy) They don't. Ash staggers a bit, rubs her head. KAT (CONT'D) Whoa. What's wrong? ASH I think I need to take a pill. MADDY (off her watch) Not for another two hours. ASH I don't mean my meds. I'm getting a migraine. MADDY Since when do you get migraines? ASH Since I started to fight back. MADDY Fight back? KAT What's that mean? ASH I decided to fight back against things I see. You know, things that happened to me after I was taken. MADDY You mean your memories? ASH Can you smell memories? It's the smell I need to push away. But when the headaches start I get too weak to do that so... MADDY

And these pills you're talking about...

ASH They gave me some in the hospital. And I thought I could get more from Victor, but--KAT Victor gave you pills. ASH His were way stronger, but he'd give me one if I begged him. KAT (to Ash) You had to beg him? ASH Or maybe that's just what it felt like. (to Maddy) Can I have one of yours? MADDY I don't have any migraine pills. ASH So whatya do when you get one? MADDY Not everyone gets migraines, Ash. ASH They don't? (rubs her temples furiously) Oh this is bad ... HANNA (to Kat) Why don't you give her something from your stash? MADDY Hanna! HANNA "Hanna!" Hanna, what? You don't

"Hanna!" Hanna, what? You don't think she has shit hidden somewhere in this place.

KAT That's all behind me. ASH (to Hanna) Yeah it is. (to Kat) But do you have something though? Because I could really use something. (another sharp pain) Please. KAT I might have... something in my coat I forgot to get rid off. (leaving) It's in the hall. HANNA I thought so. The shit she gets away with in this place. MADDY You think I should clamp down on her, eh. HANNA Yeah I do. I mean mostly for her own good. Kat returns. KAT (handing Ash a pill) Here. HANNA Just happened to have that in your pocket, eh. MADDY (to Kat) What is it. Ash swallows the pill. KAT Does it really matter? It'll handle her pain. And it was definitely my

last one.

HANNA

Yeah sure. (to Maddy) I want her punished.

MADDY (to Kat) For your own good. (to Hanna) I'll deal with her.

HANNA I want her punished!

MADDY I said I'd deal with her!

HANNA

Yeah but you won't. You'll talk to her. And that'll be it. If I break the rules I get punished. She hides drugs all over this place. She hides liquor. She even sneaks guys in here for sex sometimes. And that's definitely not on. That's a really big rule, right! I've passed up a lot of opportunities for some action because of that rule.

KAT

Sure you have.

HANNA Hey. Not everyone's turned off by a few extra pounds.

KAT You mean Victor?

MADDY

What?

HANNA Victor and I were close. So what?

MADDY

How close?

HANNA Like friends. That's all. MADDY

Hanna?

HANNA That's all!! Leave me alone for chrissake!!

ASH Stop! Please!! There's too much noise. My head...

KAT You'll feel better in a minute. Promise.

ASH Yeah but what about later. I'll need more later.

KAT I'll get you some.

MADDY No you won't. I'll call the hospital.

ASH The hospital. Yeah, they gave me some when they let me go. But I... lost them. Where was I before?

KAT Before what? The hospital?

ASH No after that. When I escaped from the hospital for awhile. Where was I then?

MADDY They found you in the ravine.

ASH Right the ravine. People there always had pills. Can we go there and ask for some?

MADDY We're not going to the friggin' ravine, Ash. I'll call the hospital like I said! Maddy's phone goes off.

MADDY (CONT'D) (into phone) Hi ... What is it? ... Oh God ... When? ... Well what do they think happened? ... Really? ... Jesus Christ ... Yeah they're all here... Why not ... No. I don't agree. I think they should know ... Well we can't just ... Of course I will. I mean as best I can but ... Yeah. Later...

She disconnects.

KAT Who was that?

MADDY Will Muncie. He's in charge of our section at the Ministry.

KAT Yeah, so what's--

MADDY

Okay. Do you remember a few weeks ago when we had that talk about how you should try to deal with unexpected things?

ASH Was I here?

KAT

No...

MADDY

Victor was talking about coping strategies for things we might not be prepared to--

ASH Where else was I? I mean where was I when I wasn't here?

MADDY You mean besides the hospital or the ravine.

ASH Yeah... HANNA How the hell are we supposed to know that. You could have been anywhere. ASH Not anywhere. Somewhere though. HANNA Jesus... (to Maddy) What's going on? KAT Yeah. What did he tell you? MADDY Okay. But try to keep everything Victor said that day in mind because-KAT Ah for fucksake, Maddy! MADDY (looks at them all) Victor's dead. HANNA (laughs) Come on. Seriously? MADDY Yes, Hanna. Seriously. You know, you really need to get control of what comes out of your mouth! And when a person is telling you something that might be kind of hard to explain because it's so ... upsetting, you should just be quiet and fucking listen! Okay!?

HANNA Whoa. Calm down.

MADDY (approaching) What?!

HANNA I just meant... Sorry. KAT (to Maddy) He just... died? He just all of a sudden--MADDY They found him in an alley. KAT They found him in an alley... dead. So he, what...? HANNA Just went into an alley and ...? ASH He was attacked. MADDY How do you know that? ASH Just a guess. MADDY A guess. ASH Yeah. I think so. They all look at her.

Blackout

SCENE 4 Ash and Kat are in the kitchen, chopping vegetables. ASH It was just a guess. People get killed in alleys all the time. That's all I was saying. I don't think Maddy believed me though. KAT Why not? ASH I've got a feeling she knows more about me than I do. Stuff about my family maybe. KAT Like what? ASH Can't be anything good. I mean what kind of people let their eleven year old daughter go hitch hiking on her own? KAT That's how old you were? ASH Yeah... KAT You were eleven years old when you were raped. ASH The first time, yeah. I was on my way to town. KAT And some guy--ASH Two guys... KAT Two guys. They picked you up and...

ASH Yeah... KAT Ah God. I didn't know that. You only told me about the other time. ASH Because the other time was worse. I escaped from the first guys. The other guys killed me. KAT What? ASH Well I'm dead, right. KAT No. Come on. You're just--ASH They put me in that basement, and I died there. So did all those other girls. KAT Except they actually did. And you escaped. You escaped from those guys too. ASH Not really. Maddy comes into the living room. MADDY Get in here. We need to talk. Come on. Hurry up. Kat leaves the kitchen and approaches Maddy. KAT What's up? You okay? Ash joins them.

> MADDY No. I'm not. Someone I knew pretty well just got fucking murdered.

KAT Yeah. Right. I guess it's been awhile since that happened to someone you hung with.

MADDY I never had a friend get killed, Kat.

KAT

Really? I had two. One got stabbed by a pimp. Wasn't even *her* pimp. Another girl I knew got run over by a cop car. That was just weird.

ASH I knew a lot of girls who got killed.

KAT I know. The ones they found in that field.

ASH Yeah. They were killed and then killed again.

MADDY

What?

KAT She means they'd already been kind of--

ASH

And before that there was the only friend I had in that basement. Cassie. She was being raped in one of the rooms they had upstairs, and she broke the guy's vodka bottle on the wall, cut his throat, and then cut her own. That was good. It was good that she took him with her. (to Maddy) So what's up?

MADDY (a beat to recover) The police want to talk to you.

ASH Just me? MADDY No. All of you. Me too. (to Ash) Go wake Hanna up, okay. Ash nods and hurries off. MADDY (CONT'D) We have to keep an eye on her, okay. KAT Sure. Like always. MADDY No she's gotten worse. Don't you think? KAT Maybe, yeah. So the cops... this is about Victor? MADDY What else? Well actually it could be about almost anything. A stupid thing you did sometime, for example. KAT Yeah, maybe. MADDY Anyway, the police have some questions for us. KAT What kind of questions? MADDY I don't know. KAT No you gotta give me an example. I need to get prepared. MADDY To do what? Lie? Just try to relax until we get there.

45.

KAT We're going to the cop shop? I don't think I can handle that. MADDY It'll be okay. KAT It's never been okay before. MADDY Yeah well you're not the same person you were. KAT Sure I am. I mean I'm not doing all the same shit. But I still have trouble talking to cops. Anytime they've ever been in my face, they've thrown a bunch of crap at me and--MADDY And what? You panicked? Confessed when you didn't mean to? KAT Well not exactly, but--MADDY Did you kill him? KAT What? MADDY Did you fucking kill Victor? KAT No. Jesus. MADDY Okay so just try to remember that before you open your mouth. Ash comes back in. ASH Her door's locked. I knocked and yelled a little, but she didn't--

MADDY I'll get her.

KAT

How?

MADDY I've got a key.

KAT Just to *her* room?

MADDY No. To all of them.

She leaves.

KAT Weird. Why would she have keys to all our rooms?

ASH Maybe for emergencies...

KAT Emergencies. You mean like a...

ASH Like a fire, yeah.

Maddy comes in.

KAT What's going on?

MADDY

You tell me.

She is followed closely by Max and Hanna. Max has just finished getting dressed. Hanna is wrapped in a large blanket.

KAT (off them both) What the fuck is this?

MADDY Hanna says this young man is your brother.

MAX I am. KAT (to Max) Jesus. What were you doing with --MADDY Since when do you have a brother? KAT Since yesterday maybe. MAX No. It was yesterday. Maddy's cell goes off. She steps away to answer it. KAT I meant maybe I have a brother. (to Hanna) Are you so hard up you'll bone anyone? He's just a kid. MAX It's no biggy. I do it a lot. KAT Yeah? And do you usually do it with freak shows like her? HANNA (to Max) I told you she'd get nasty about it. (to Kat) What's it to you anyway. You don't even know him. And if you'd been awake to say hi when he got here, I wouldn't have had to entertain him. KAT (to Max) I guess you made her shower first. She usually smells like a herd of goats. HANNA (to Max)

Ask her how many guys came on her face last night. (MORE) HANNA (CONT'D) (to Kat) Whore.

KAT Yes. You are.

Maddy steps back in.

MADDY Okay knock it off. That was the police making sure we're coming. (to Hanna) Go finish getting dressed.

HANNA I'm already dressed.

KAT You're gonna wear that horse blanket to the police station.

MADDY (to Hanna) They want to talk to us about Victor.

HANNA Okay. So why can't they come here?

MADDY

Because I don't want the neighbours seeing police visit this house any more than they already have.

HANNA (to Ash) That was your fault. (to Max) She tried to burn us all alive once.

ASH

(to Max) I had problems. But I'm a little better now.

KAT She means it was an accident.

ASH I forgot there were other people in the house. I was supposed to be the only one who--HANNA Got burned to a crisp? ASH Yeah... (puts out her hand to Max) Ash. MAX Max. ASH And you're her actual brother? MAX Yeah. ASH (to Kat) How about that. KAT Yeah. Effing wow. ASH Think I better put something clean on. You know, to make a better impression. MADDY Good plan. And maybe lose a few of the piercings. ASH I just put them back in when they let me out of the hospital ... MADDY I know. But they're cops, honey. They think a certain way about things. Lose whatever you can without harming yourself.

HANNA She means don't just yank the friggin' thing out of your nose. ASH That's funny. (to Kat) She says funny things sometimes.

Ash leaves.

HANNA I don't like the way she said that. She's even freakier than she used to be.

Hanna leaves.

MADDY (to Kat) What's cooking in there?

KAT We were making some kind of stew. Ash had a recipe in her head, but she wasn't sure about all the--

MADDY It smells awful.

KAT Yeah maybe we should toss it.

MADDY No that'll hurt her feelings. I'll just put it in the fridge for now.

Maddy heads for the kitchen.

Kat looks at Max.

KAT So did you have fun up there?

MAX

Well she cried a few times. And that was kinda strange. But basically, it was nice. I like her.

KAT Oh good... So this isn't next week like I suggested. MAX No. But... (he takes a note out of his pocket) I wanted to give you this. (hands it to her) It's from our... dad. He wants you to call him.

KAT

Call him. Not go see him. Just call him.

MAX

To start with, yeah. Like he says in the note. He thinks we should go slow.

KAT Sure. I get that. What's the hurry? You think he'd be a bit more excited to see me, that's all.

MAX

Oh he's excited, I think. He got pretty worked up when I told him I'd found you.

KAT

What's that mean, worked up?

MAX

He cried. A lot. Took him awhile to get it together too. I mean eventually he did because he didn't want my mum to hear him. The thing is, he doesn't think she could handle knowing about you. Not without a little preparation... So do you think you might do that? Call him?

KAT

Probably not.

MAX

Right. So... probably not. That could actually mean maybe. Right?

KAT What? Yeah. I guess it could butMAX Good. So how've you been?

KAT Since yesterday?

MAX

Yeah. Whatya been up to? I mean Hanna told me about that social worker getting killed.

KAT Yeah. That happened.

MAX

Right. And now you're off to talk to the cops about it. You have any ideas about who did it?

KAT Yeah. Lots of them. But I think I'll keep them to myself for now.

Maddy comes in from kitchen.

MADDY (to Kat) You ready?

KAT

Sure.

MADDY (yelling off) Hanna! You coming!?

HANNA

(off) Hold on!

MADDY (to Max) So can you wait for us?

KAT Why would he want to do that?

MADDY So we can have a talk. KAT About what?

MADDY About you. What else?

Hanna appears in a very nice outfit.

HANNA Okay. Let's go.

They all start out.

MADDY That's a pretty dress, Hanna.

HANNA Thanks. I was saving it for a special occasion.

KAT And a trip to the police station qualifies.

Ash appears with fewer piercings. And she is wearing a clean shirt.

Better?

MADDY Definitely. (to Max) Make yourself at home.

ASH

The women leave.

Max looks around.

MAX Sure... Okay...

He sits.

Blackout

SCENE 5 Max is gone. Kat storms in, very agitated. KAT Fucking dumb-ass bullies. I mean the smirk on that one motherfucker's face when Ash started to cry?! Maddy enters. KAT (CONT'D) I wanted to break a chair over the dumb prick's head... MADDY Okay calm down! KAT No fuck that. She's out there somewhere now, and she's gonna hurt herself! MADDY No she's not. KAT Yes she fucking is! When she's upset like this, she hears them call her. Hanna comes in. HANNA Hears who call her? KAT The voices in the pit. MADDY The pit. You mean the cage in that basement. HANNA I've never heard her talk about any voices.

KAT To me! She talks about them to me. They're the voices of the girls who never got out. MADDY And what are they saying to her? KAT They want her to come back and be with them. HANNA But they're dead, right. KAT Yeah those evil freaks shot them all when the cops were closing in. And sometimes Ash hears them asking her to join them. MADDY You mean asking her to kill herself. KAT Yeah. And she thinks she should. MADDY Because she believes it was her fault. KAT Which it wasn't. HANNA Except it kind of was. (to Maddy) After she escaped she took the cops to that farmhouse where they were. KAT She told you that? HANNA No I heard her telling you.

KAT You mean when you were spying on us. HANNA Well how else am I supposed to find out what's going on around here. (to Maddy) Anyway that's why she's so upset.

KAT

Yeah? You don't think it has anything to do with being accused of murder and then chased out of a police station by a couple of totally outta control idiot cops!?

HANNA They weren't outta control.

KAT

Shut up.

HANNA They were just doing their jobs.

KAT I told you to shut your slobbering gob! You keep talking and I'll put my fist through your face!

HANNA Like I'm afraid of--

Kat rushes her and is about to pound on her. Maddy intervenes and grabs Kat from behind.

MADDY Kat. Get off her!

KAT (to Hanna) I warned you, didn't I. But you can't ever just shut the fuck up!!

MADDY Kat! Knock it off!!

Maddy with a very large effort manages to pull Kat away.

MADDY (CONT'D) For chrissake! I am so sick of this crap between the two of you!

KAT Look I know how she felt, okay. I know what it's like when cops zero in on you like that. And it was all because of the garbage this fool was telling them about her! Maddy's phone buzzes. She takes it into the kitchen. HANNA It was the truth! She's dangerous. KAT To herself. HANNA Oh yeah? What about the fire? And she hit me once. KAT Everyone you know has probably hit you at least once. You told me Victor hit you for mouthing off to him. HANNA It was just a slap. And so what? KAT So maybe you killed him! HANNA Ash killed him. She basically admitted it. KAT No she didn't. She said she'd had a blackout. HANNA While she was with Victor. KAT While she was looking for Victor. HANNA Well you put two and two together and you can assume she found him. The cops did.

KAT After you went on about her

sometimes being "outta control."

HANNA

I should withhold evidence?

KAT

You should keep everything you think you know inside your ridiculous brain, and just stay in bed all day sucking on Gummy Bears.

HANNA I've got low blood sugar!

KAT Okay here we go...

HANNA

Low blood sugar, deep anxiety and very low self esteem because of all the neglect I've had to suffer through.

KAT From the very beginning, right.

HANNA

Right. Even when I was first born. None of the nurses would come near me!

Maddy returns. Putting away her phone.

KAT

TA1

(to Maddy) Help me out here. She's disappearing up her own asshole again.

MADDY

Look, Hanna. No one thinks you don't have serious problems--

HANNA

(off Kat) Except her.

MADDY

Well she doesn't know all your history. But that stuff you told the police about Ash, it was like you were trying really hard to *make* them think it was her who killed Victor.

HANNA

I was just pointing them in a direction.

MADDY A very specific direction.

KAT

And if Ash does anything to herself--

HANNA

It'll be because that's what she was going to do anyway. Look, I'm sorry about all those things she went through. Being a sex slave, that's really ugly. But if she's totally damaged then--

KAT Then what? We should just let her rot in jail!?

HANNA (to Maddy) Who was that on the phone?

KAT Was it the cops?

MADDY

No.

HANNA

Was it Ash?

MADDY No. Look it's not--

HANNA So who was it? Had to be someone.

MADDY It was just a friend. HANNA You don't have any friends. MADDY Fuck off. HANNA Hey. You can't talk to me like that. MADDY Why not? HANNA Because you're not allowed. Because of your position. MADDY Right. I forgot. But fuck off anyway. Max comes in with two bags of groceries. They look at him. MAX While I was waiting I got a little hungry, but there wasn't much in the kitchen so--MADDY You went shopping for us? MAX Well you were gone all night, so I thought when you got back I could make you breakfast. What did the cops want? Where's Ash? HANNA We don't know. KAT (to Max) Yeah. Do that. MAX Do what?

KAT Make us breakfast. I mean it's the only reason I can think of for you to be here, so... MAX Yeah. Sure. Okay... He starts into kitchen. Stops. MAX (CONT'D) About that call to Dad. It might be too complicated to get rolling on that right now. KAT Whatever HANNA (to Max) How long are you going be staying anyway? KAT Why, you hoping to get another shot at him? HANNA I'm just wondering how he can be away from home this long? MAX My parents think I'm at one of my cousins' place. KAT You've got cousins. Wow. There's a whole bunch of you in that family, eh. MAX Yeah. And this one cousin let's me stay there when it gets hard to be around them. KAT You mean Tom and Julia. MADDY Who are they?

MAX Our parents... I'll get breakfast going.

He starts off again. Stops.

MAX (CONT'D) Oh yeah, so what did the cops want?

MADDY Just to ask us some questions.

MAX Okay. So everything is all right?

KAT Just concentrate on breakfast, okay.

HANNA (to Max) Can you do eggs benedict?

MAX

What?

KAT Don't worry about it. Put whatever you make in something that looks like a trough, and she'll be fine.

Max goes into the kitchen.

MADDY What is that he does wants from you, Kat?

KAT Probably nothing I can give him.

HANNA

He's lonely. (off Kat's look) He told me when we were upstairs. After his little sister died his parents stopped talking...

KAT

To him.

HANNA

Yeah. And each other. Sounds pretty bleak there. He thinks he's not enough.

KAT What's that mean, not enough?

HANNA Not enough to help his mother. He thinks she just needs her daughter back.

KAT The one who died.

MADDY

Or maybe the one who's still alive. Look you need to talk all this through with him. When you're allowed to leave here and spend more time with him, you can-

KAT

Whatya mean, when I'm "allowed". I'm 18. I can leave whenever I want.

MADDY

No. Sorry. I told the police I'd be responsible for you until--

KAT

Until what?

MADDY

Victor was killed. They don't know who did it. So...

KAT

So they think it might be me. I mean if it wasn't Ash.

HANNA

Well you'd be next on my list for sure. If they think it was someone who had a problem with him, that'd be you, wouldn't it.

KAT But not you. HANNA

I never got into a fist fight with the man like you did.

KAT

No you just sent him threatening emails.

HANNA There was no proof that was me.

KAT You're the proof, idiot. It wouldn't be the first time you'd--

HANNA That's in my past. All that happened when I was someone else.

KAT We were all someone else, Hanna.

HANNA Except for you. You're still the nightmare you always were.

MADDY

Shut up. Both of you. You can't go anywhere either, Hanna. They want you both staying put.

HANNA Well good luck with that. How are you going to stop *her* from sneaking out every night,

MADDY I'm going to ask her not to.

HANNA

Oh. Good plan.

KAT

(to Maddy) No. I'll stop. I thought you were okay with it.

MADDY

It was what you needed to do at the time.

HANNA You mean screw half the city? KAT (to Maddy) I don't know why it makes her happy to think that. (to Hanna) I walk, Hanna. That's what I do. Maddy gets another call. She leaves. HANNA You walk. You just walk around all night. KAT Not all night. For three or four hours maybe. It's a habit I picked up when I was on the street. Walking felt safer than sleeping. HANNA Okay. I get that. KAT Oh well good for you then. HANNA And you never get laid. KAT Only when I meet someone who--HANNA Who has a dick. KAT Not necessarily. And seriously, what the fuck's it to you anyway. It's not my fault you don't get any action. HANNA I've had my share. KAT Who with?

66.

HANNA With a lot of the girls who've come through here, that's who. KAT Name one. Come on. Just one and I'll shut up. HANNA Okay. Cara. KAT Cara. She was blind, right. HANNA Partially blind. KAT You mean blind enough. HANNA Oh go fuck yourself. KAT Sure. You wanna watch?

Maddy comes back in.

KAT (CONT'D) (to Maddy) So Ash and me are the only ones on the cops' list. (off Hanna) What about her?

MADDY No one's told me she's in the clear either.

HANNA They haven't?

KAT And what about all the other girls who've come through this place that Victor mighta pissed off?

MAX (steps out of kitchen) Five minutes. Maybe someone can set the table. They look at each other.

MADDY A reasonable request.

Kat and Hanna get to the task.

KAT Who was on the phone that time?

MADDY

Muncie. (off her look) Will Muncie? My boss? It was him the last time too.

HANNA So why didn't you tell us that?

MADDY Because I'd just hung up on him and...

She is just looking at them.

KAT What is it?

MADDY

The police have been looking into *all* of us and--

KAT

They found out you had a record.

MADDY

Yeah. But Will knew that. What he didn't know is that I'm currently seeing a psychiatrist.

HANNA

You are?

MADDY Yes, Hanna. I am.

KAT And he's got a problem with you doing that?

MADDY

He wants me to tell him why I'm doing it. And I'm wondering why can't I be allowed to have issues just like anyone else.

KAT

You can. (to Hanna) Right?

HANNA

Maybe. As long as her issues don't get in the way of my issues.

MADDY

I bet half the social workers in this city are in some kind of therapy. I guess I was supposed to leave my troubled past behind and become a completely new person. I'll see if he needs any help in there.

She goes into kitchen.

HANNA

So the cops are looking at her now too.

KAT

I guess people think there's a point when everything someone's been through just disappears from their brains, and they become normal. But maybe they don't. And maybe the never will.

HANNA

Well you won't, that's for sure. You'll always be messed up and dangerous. Why are you smiling? It's the truth.

KAT

Maybe. But the truth about you is a lot scarier.

HANNA

Sure it is.

KAT Yeah these problems you say you had with your family, that's just smoke. You're actually a fucking psycho, right.

Hanna continues putting down the plates

KAT (CONT'D) (laying out cutlery) You didn't wind up in the system because your family ignored you. When you were in Juvie, there was friend of mine in there too. And there was a lot of talk about you, girl. There aren't that many violent female stalkers. That's something guys usually do.

Hanna is trying to ignore her. Kat closes in.

KAT (CONT'D) I know you've had some action here. But it wasn't from any of the girls. That thing you and Victor had going on before he dumped you... If the cops find out about that, you become suspect number one.

HANNA

No way.

KAT Come on, with what I was told you did to the first person who ended it with you. That sweet little neighbour girl. That was ugly, Hanna. Even to me.

Hanna suddenly picks up a fork from the table. Turns on Kat with it.

KAT (CONT'D) Really? A fork?

HANNA Get outta my face or this goes in your fucking eye.

KAT Chill, Hon. I'm not gonna say anything to the cops. Not if you stop trying to put what happened to Victor on Ash. She's been through more than enough, don't ya think. (closer) Don't you!? HANNA Yeah... Okay... I guess she has. They continue to set the table. Max and Maddy bring out the breakfast. MAX Scrambled eggs and toast. It's all I really know how to do. KAT Looks good. MAX (serving) Thanks. They all sit around the table except Hanna. MADDY Hanna? HANNA I'm not hungry. She leaves. KAT (to Max) I told you to put it in a trough. Blackout.

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SCENE 6 Night Max on the couch, sleeping. Ash comes in from outside, quietly. Max stirs, sits up. ASH Are they all asleep? MAX Yeah, I think so. ASH I just came for food. She heads into kitchen. MAX Oh okay. I did some shopping, so there's a bunch of stuff in the fridge. ASH (from kitchen) You went shopping for them? MAX I was trying to be helpful. ASH (from kitchen) So they'd let you stay. She comes out of the kitchen with a jar of pickles. ASH (CONT'D) (eating a pickle) Good plan. None of them like to cook. So if you can handle that for them you can probably stay as long as you need to. You got trouble at home? MAX Yeah. Well not like the kind of trouble you're in.

ASH Yeah. I'm in the shit.

MAX

Did you kill that man?

ASH

I can't remember. I might have. Victor was too much sometimes. Too pushy, too mean... and, you know, other things. He wasn't allowed to live here, but he checked in all the time. Maybe the basement? Yeah I could hide down there until...

MAX

Until what?

ASH I dunno. Until something. Would you be okay not telling them I was there.

MAX I could probably tell Kat. She seems pretty cool.

ASH

Yeah but she'd still want me to give myself up. You know, thinking it'd be best in the long run. I don't know about that right now. Tomorrow could be different. I might remember something. Then I might know something. Did you buy cheese? I could sure use some cheese.

MAX

Okay...

He goes into kitchen.

ASH Nothing soft. Or creamy. Very old cheddar! You get something strong like that?!

MAX (sticks his head out) Shh. You'll wake them up... (MORE)

MAX (CONT'D) (listens) Too late. Someone is coming down. ASH Shit. She runs into kitchen ... Kat comes in. Looking around. Max comes out of the kitchen. KAT What's going on?. I heard someone. MAX That was me. KAT What? Talking to yourself? MAX I guess. I was looking through the fridge... thinking what I could make for dinner. KAT Dinner. MAX I mean if that's okay. I'm a guy, right. And I know guys aren't supposed to be living here. KAT You're living here now? MAX No. But you know what I mean. I'm a--KAT You're a guy, yeah. You know what, I don't think anyone cares. They must think you're harmless. MAX I am.

74.

KAT Right. So go ahead. Plan your dinner menu. I'll just... She stretches out on the couch. MAX You're not going back to sleep? KAT I wasn't asleep. I was just lying there. Might as well do that here. MAX You have trouble sleeping, eh? Me too. I mean I did. After I started high school. KAT Too much pressure? MAX Too much Oxi. KAT Ah shit. (sits up) Go away. I can't deal with that. MAX No it's okay. I stopped awhile ago. I only started because it all got to be too much. Leanne dying. My mum getting sick. How about you? KAT What? MAX What was your "too much?" KAT Nothing. (off his look) Too much nothing. Nothing to look forward to mostly. Didn't see how

the future could be any different than the past. Except maybe worse. MAX Well you're eighteen, so at least they can't put you in foster care again.

KAT Yeah, but there was usually food in foster care. And on the street

foster care. And on the street getting hungry makes you do things...

MAX (sitting by her feet on the couch) What about getting a job.

KAT

Getting one's possible. Keeping one's the problem. (off his look) I have a lot of trouble being told what to do. I mean it's hard to go from no one caring about you to having people boss you around. How come you don't want me to phone "Dad" all of a sudden.

MAX

I just think he needs more time to figure things out.

KAT

That sounds like a load of crap. Are we gonna have a relationship based on crap, Max.

MAX

He's not over losing Leanne, and he's having a really tough time dealing with Mum's problems. The thing is, he's kind of weak, and I'm worried he'll do something stupid and wind up in prison again.

KAT

Really?

MAX Yeah. But I'm not giving up.

KAT

You probably should. Look it's gonna be hard enough for me going forward. Going back might just give me more garbage to deal with. Plus I'm extra pissed off with Mister and Missus Harvey now that I find out they had this big family they coulda asked for help.

MAX

You mean so they could keep you. All that family you're talking about, they're mostly fuck ups. A few of them are okay. But none of them have any money and they're always mooching off mum and dad. (off her look) What's wrong?

KAT

I don't know how to feel about that. I mean there's "yay for me" for avoiding all of it. But it's still family, right. Still my family. (sits up) I need to hit the street.

She hurries out.

Ash comes out of the kitchen, eating cheddar cheese.

ASH That's where she heads when she's got a lot of shit to work out. Problem is she sometimes does stuff out there that makes it worse.

MAX I think I've already made it worse for her.

ASH Maybe. But at least you're here. She's never had anyone before.

Pointing to the blanket on the couch.

ASH (CONT'D) I think I'll need that. She takes it. ASH (CONT'D) The floor down there is probably pretty cold. MAX You're going to sleep on the basement floor? ASH Won't be the first time. (off his look) Not this basement. A couple of others though. Don't worry. I'm not going to tell you about it. It would only make you feel really sorry for me. And I don't need anymore of that shit in my life. She heads into the basement.

Blackout

SCENE 7

Hanna is at the table. In a bathrobe. Her hair wet. Max is pouring her cereal.

HANNA What are you now? Our butler?

MAX Just trying to help out while I'm here.

HANNA And how long is that gonna be?

MAX Until I'm asked to leave, I guess.

HANNA

So bringing Kat into the mix, that stirred things up at home. I wouldn't bother pushing it. She won't fit in. She doesn't fit in anywhere.

MAX That's not all her fault though, right.

HANNA If you say so.

MAX

Well whatever's wrong with you, is that all your fault? I mean you're here, aren't you? And you were in Juvie, so you must have done something wrong.

HANNA Maybe I was innocent. Did you ever consider that?

MAX

Were you?

HANNA I gave my affection to the wrong person. (MORE)

HANNA (CONT'D)

She was a neighbour and a friend and I thought she cared about me. But she didn't. Not really. Not enough. Not in the way I needed her to. And that deeply disappointed me and made me very very angry. So... technically what I did, or tried to do, to that person was against the law. But really on a human level, adding in how often I was left alone by my parents, it was totally understandable.

MAX

I wish my parents would leave me alone more.

HANNA

I wasn't actually finished talking about myself. But okay... your parents. Go ahead.

MAX

It's just that they rely on me too much. I know it's been hard for them, and I try to help... but I'm still basically a kid, right.

HANNA

Well at least they're in the same city as you are. Mine did most of their living in other countries. And I was never allowed to complain about it. "Do you like this lifestyle our business is providing for you or not?" "If the answer is yes, try to suck it up and make some friends for godsake."

MAX

That's your parents talking?

HANNA

No that's what they were probably thinking. I mean have they visited me here? Not even once. Okay I told them not to. I told them I'd slit my throat if they did, but even so...

(looks at him) (MORE) HANNA (CONT'D)

By the way, where'd you sleep last night?

MAX On the couch.

HANNA Okay, so that feels like rejection. Was it? Were you

rejecting me by sleeping down here?

Max heads into kitchen.

HANNA (CONT'D) Where are you going? I was just asking a simple question.

MAX I'm gonna make you some toast.

HANNA Well that's different. As long as you're not avoiding the issue. Lots of butter. Not margarine. And marmalade. Okay? Marmalade!

MAX

(off) Got it.

HANNA Where's everyone else?

MAX

(off) Out. Kat left when it was still dark. And Maddy went to see the police.

HANNA About Ash?

MAX

(off) Dunno.

HANNA Maybe they found her. MAX

(off) Maybe.

HANNA

Well if they didn't, I think she should just turn herself in. With her background they'll definitely go easy on her.

MAX

(out of kitchen) How can they go easy on someone they think is a murderer?

HANNA

Come on. With what she went through. It was the worst. And not even with the same people. She was sold twice. What about my toast?

MAX

Right.

He heads back into kitchen.

MAX (CONT'D) (off) But she might not have done it. I don't think she really believes she did.

HANNA You've been talking to her?

Ash comes in. Wrapped in blanket. Shivering. Dirty. Messed up.

ASH Yeah we had a little chat.

HANNA Jesus. Where you been?

ASH

Basement.

HANNA All this time?

83.

ASH No. Just last night.

Max brings out Hanna's toast.

MAX (to Ash) Are you okay?

ASH Could I get a coffee?

MAX

Sure.

He heads back into kitchen.

ASH Just black, okay. (to Hanna) This is cool. It's like we're in a restaurant, isn't it.

HANNA Maybe in your fucked up head it is. Maybe next you'll be thinking we're having a picnic by the lake or something.

ASH That's funny. (to Max) She can be very funny when she wants to be.

MAX

Yeah...

HANNA (to Ash) What's up with all the running and hiding?

ASH It seemed like something I needed to do.

HANNA Well it's not helping anyone, I can tell you that. (MORE)

84.

HANNA (CONT'D)

Until they can be sure it was you who bashed his head in, I might still be a suspect. Kat is for sure.

ASH

Yeah. Okay. But I don't think I should lie about it.

HANNA So you're saying you didn't kill the man.

ASH I'm saying I don't know. So it'd be a lie to say I did, wouldn't it.

HANNA

So what? What's a fucking lie under these circumstances. I mean what are they going to do to you. You'll be sent back to the hospital for a few years and then... whatever.

MAX (out with Ash's coffee) What's that mean? Whatever?

HANNA

Well that's what's going to happen to her no matter what. A lot of whatevers and who the fuck knows. (to Ash) Right?

ASH

I guess.

MAX

Okay but--

HANNA Stay out of it. We're trying to get this thing sorted.

MAX I understand, but--

HANNA (standing) I mean it. Butt the fuck out! ASH (to Max) It's okay. She's just scared. (to Hanna) I'll think about it. Okay?

MAX Think about what? Confessing to something without knowing if you did it?

ASH But I can remember hating him. So there's probably more chance that I did than I didn't.

HANNA Just what I've been saying. Here. Have some of my toast.

MAX (to Ash) I'll make you some eggs if you want.

ASH You will? Thanks.

He smiles, goes back into the kitchen.

HANNA

Me too. (no response.) Did you hear me?! Eggs for me too!

MAX

Sure.

HANNA

(looks at Ash) You had a rough night down there, eh. Maddy says there are rats in that basement.

ASH

I like rats.

HANNA

Yeah I forgot.

Kat comes in. She also looks pretty rough.

KAT (taking in Ash) Hey. What the --HANNA She spent the night in the basement. KAT (to Ash) Why? HANNA Because she's on the run, why else. How did you spend your night? Bent over a park bench, taking it in the ass? KAT Not now, Creepy Girl. HANNA I'm just wondering why you look so--KAT That means shut the fuck up, okay! Jesus, Ash. The cops were just--ASH They scared me. KAT Okay, but they were just asking questions. HANNA Questions she couldn't answer. Questions that were maybe leading to the truth. KAT Which is? HANNA You know what it is. KAT No I don't. And neither do you. Why? Just tell me why she'd wanna kill the guy?

86.

ASH Because I hated him? HANNA Yeah. And because you're not right in your freakin' head. MAX (coming in) I know someone who isn't right in her head. And she's never going to kill anyone. Except maybe herself. HANNA Who's that. KAT His mother. HANNA You mean your mother. (to Max) Jesus. If she's in bad shape now, wait until she has to start dealing... (off Kat) ... with this one. MAX No I think it'll help. ASH It helped me. HANNA What did? ASH What he said about his mother. Because I don't really want to hurt anyone most of the time either. I just have these other times when I can't figure out where I am or where I might be. I mean where I might still be. And that maybe I should do something to protect myself. And that makes me ...

HANNA (quietly to Max) Really fucking dangerous. I don't know if I had a reason to kill Victor. He was on me a lot to forget about the situation I was in. Telling me all the time that if I'd just try to be stronger, things would be okay.

KAT

That's what he thought about all of us. That we were just weak. It was like we disgusted him or something.

HANNA Not me. He liked me.

KAT

He wanted to fuck you. Just like he wanted to fuck me.

ASH

And me.

KAT (to Hanna) Only difference is, you let him. And we didn't.

ASH

I think that's probably why I bit him. He was always grabbing me.

KAT

Me too. Grabbing my tits, my ass, trying to kiss me. Shove his hand down my pants. It was really gross. And pathetic. I felt sorry for him at first. I mean he was pretty old, right. Then no, fuck that. I mean here we were "under his supervision" and none of us in great shape... But he didn't see us as anything except targets.

HANNA

He was lonely.

KAT

What?

HANNA He'd get carried away. That's all. Just because he wanted to have sex with us didn't mean he didn't like us. And he was very tender with me. KAT Tender. Okay. You're definitely the most messed up person I've ever met. ASH Including me? KAT You're different. You were--ASH Killed. The person I was... was killed. KAT Yeah... in a way. HANNA (suddenly) He liked me! That's why he did it with me. (off Max) It's the same reason he had for doing it with me. He liked me. Even though he's gonna deny it now. MAX No I still kinda like you. You just scare me. HANNA I scare you. But you're willing to have... (off Kat) ... this violent freak in your family? She tried to crack my skull open two days ago. And she does shit like that all the time. MAX

She used to.

HANNA Used to, my ass. (to Kat) Tell him. Tell him what you've done to me! And how you knocked out two of Victor's teeth. And what you'll probably do to his family at some point. (to Max) By the way, fuck you with that I "scare" you crap. Hanna leaves the room. KAT (to Ash) It doesn't matter. I'm not going anywhere near his family. MAX She means not right now. KAT Not ever. ASH Not even if you're homeless again. KAT No. Not even then. MAX Okay, then I better stay with you. KAT Why? MAX Because you need someone to be with you. Unless you know a lot of other people who want to help you. KAT Help me how? Look never mind. Just go home. I'm leaving here in a little while anyway. MAX Yeah. And I'm coming with you. Hanna comes in, wiping her eyes with a damp cloth.

90.

HANNA To where? KAT Shut up... Hey, have you been crying? HANNA Who cares? (to Max) She has no idea where she'll wind up. (to Kat) Do you? KAT No I don't. HANNA Well there you go. Hanna goes into the kitchen. MAX (to Kat) There's no way I can just say goodbye to you now. ASH He's right. It's too sad. Leaving people behind is the worst thing ever. You'll hate yourself. KAT He's still in school. MAX I can always go to school later. ASH He's right. And you need what you've always needed. Some kind of family. KAT I can take you. You're some kind of family.

Hanna comes out of the kitchen, opening a can of peaches.

HANNA But she'll be in jail. KAT Look just be quiet, okay. I'm asking you nicely. Hanna is fishing the peach slices out of the can with her fingers. HANNA Either in jail or a mental hospital. ASH She told you to be quiet! HANNA Or grabbed by some other psychos and--ASH Hey!! That's not funny, okay. (up fast) So shut the fuck up, you knownothing bitch! Ash pulls a switchblade and flicks it open. HANNA (standing and backing away) Ah, what the... KAT Ash. ASH Tell her she needs to keep her mouth closed. KAT Okay, but please --ASH Just tell her! HANNA It's okay. I hear you. Look back off, okay. I'm really scared.

ASH

Are you?

HANNA

Yes...

ASH

I'm sorry... But I can't take any
of your shit right now. Unless it's
funny. And that wasn't funny.
 (points to her head)

I've had a lot of noise going on in here. And I've been trying to make it stop. But when I woke up in that basement it was like I was back in that cage with the all the others. And they were my friends.

(crying) My friends, okay! So what's going on with me? I mean really. I can't keep thinking about that. It's not good. Because those other girls are dead. They're not still in that cage. They're not still calling me. They found them in that fucking field, all of them just lying there together. Not even buried. Just left there like garbage. And maybe I'm just waiting to be used and killed and thrown away too. Because that could happen again, right. I could get grabbed again. From anywhere, really. Because nowhere is safe really. That road wasn't safe for an eleven year old girl. That park wasn't safe for a fifteen year old. Not even in the middle of the day.

(off knife) And that's why I need this knife. Middle of the day. Sun shining. Kids in the playground. And their parents, not even that far away, none of them saw or heard what was happening to me. Arm around my neck. A cloth over my mouth. Then darkness. And then it was two years of being visited. Taken for a shower. Taken to a room. Waiting for whoever it was to come in. (MORE)

ASH (CONT'D) I was dead for most of the time near the end. I felt dead. Beat up and used and dead. KAT I know. ASH Yeah. But... (off Hanna) Does she? HANNA I do now. ASH You do? HANNA Yeah... ASH Good. That's good. So keep quiet, okay, and let me think about leaving this place with my friends here. HANNA Okay... ASH (sitting) Okay. So I'll just think about that. And then make a decision. KAT All right. Can you get rid of the knife though. ASH Sure. No problem. Ash pockets the knife. KAT I think it's better if you give it to me. ASH

94.

No. I can't do that.

KAT ASH

No. I can't... do... that!! (to Hanna) Don't worry. I'm not mad at you anymore.

HANNA

Oh, good.

Ash.

Hanna sits.

Maddy comes in.

MADDY Hi, Ash. Welcome home.

ASH

Thanks...

MADDY You look a little ragged. What's been goin' on?

Ash just shrugs.

HANNA

She slept in the basement. But I didn't know that at the time.

KAT

You mean or you would have turned her in.

HANNA

For her own good, sure. Am I the only one who gets how serious this situation is?

MADDY

I've got a fair idea. The police have a person who saw someone in the alley behind Victor's house. They were passing out your photos in the neighbourhood and that person--

KAT Recognized one of us?

MADDY

I think we should talk about how we're going to handle this.

HANNA What's that mean? Handle it?

MADDY

Well we know quite a lot about each other, don't we? Maybe we know enough to show each other some sympathy. We understand that because of all we've been through, this is not a normal situation. We can't deal with problems that come up the way most people, including the police, would. Because we know the consequences could be very severe. Maybe deserved. Maybe not. But definitely more damaging to any one of us than it would be to most others. So what I'm saying is... we need to talk about that a bit. You know, to see if there's anything we can do to make those consequences any less severe.

She sits at the table,

MADDY (CONT'D) Max. Can you fix us a little snack?

KAT A snack. We're going to have a snack while we talk about this.

MADDY If that's okay with everyone.

They all look at Hanna.

HANNA What? I can say no to a snack. I can do that. (to Maddy) But... food calms people and helps them think more clearly, doesn't it?

MADDY It can, yeah.

ASH So let's have a snack then. (to Kat) Okay? KAT Sure. MAX (heads into kitchen) Coming right up. MADDY I'll make sure thee's enough to go around. Hanna goes into the kitchen Maddy looks at Kat then beckons Ash to sit next to her. MADDY (CONT'D) Come over here. ASH Oh... (sits on the couch) This is going to be bad, isn't it. (to Kat) I'm going to get locked up again. Kat sits on the other side of Ash. KAT (hugs her) I won't let them hurt you. (crying) I won't... ever... let them hurt you...

Blackout

97.

SCENE 8

Kat and Max on the couch.

MAX When I was a little kid I wanted to be a cop.

KAT

So did I.

MAX

Really?

KAT

Yeah I liked they way they took control of a situation and made it better. Bad people were taken away, and everyone else could get on with their lives. I mean it coulda gotten way worse in those situations without them showing up. And then later... I was the person they were showing up to take away. So that was different. That was a war I was in, and the cops always won. Because I couldn't get what was going on inside me under control. Still can't sometimes.

MAX

And that's anger, right.

KAT

Maddy's says it's really fear. The kind of fear that comes from having no support. I mean she calls it support. I call it having a better life. Something or someone that you know is gonna be there no matter how bad it gets.

MAX

Like me.

KAT Someone who wants to help make it better.

MAX Like I do. KAT Someone who'd have a hard time giving up on me. MAX I'll never do that. Promise. KAT Okay. If you say so. (a gentle punch on his arm) Maddy told me I'd find someone like that one day. MAX You mean me. Not someone. Me. KAT Okay, yeah. MAX Except I found you. But that thing about fear, that sounds right. Maddy's pretty good at this. Helping you figure things out, I mean. KAT Yeah... MAX What about Victor? Did he ever help like that? KAT I don't wanna talk about Victor. MAX Okay... KAT I mean what's the point. (thinks) I think he must have wanted to help at the beginning. But not for awhile. So fuck him.

100.

MAX

Right.

KAT

I mean why get into that work if helping isn't what you wanna do. No matter now tired you get or disappointed you get. And when someone's supposed to help you and doesn't act like he even gives a shit about you, you're gonna have a real problem with him. I did. And Ash did too. In her own way... which was to resent any "suggestions" he made that didn't look sincere. And Victor did not look sincere most of the time. And when he started to... to get personal, well that was just too fucking much.

(looks at Max)
I think sometime, maybe when...
your mother's a little better, I'd
like to meet our--

MAX

Mum's not gonna get better. Not without you there.

KAT

What? No that's just some idea you've got in your head, but it's not--

MAX

I know it's the only thing that will help her. Losing Leanne and not having you there... not *ever* having had you there, is this big awful sadness she's got in her that won't go away. It's just too...

KAT Don't cry, man. I can't--

MAX

No no it's okay. I was just... Anyway we've gotta give Dad some time to just suck it up. We can move around if you want or stay here.

(MORE)

101. MAX (CONT'D) Then in a little while we let him meet you, and see how much you look like Mum and--KAT I do? I look like her? MAX Oh yeah. And when he sees that and gets to know you like I already do, then--KAT And how's that? How do you know me? MAX Well... I guess I know you well enough to love you. Kat just looks at him. KAT Really. MAX Yeah. He takes her hand. KAT Jesus... MAX Don't cry, man. KAT (is she?) Me? Cry? No worries there. No, sir... Hanna comes in. Sits next to them. HANNA They're leaving. KAT Right now? HANNA Yeah... What's wrong with you two?

Nothing...

KAT

We're fine.

Maddy comes in. Followed by a cleaned up Ash.

MAX

MADDY Okay. We're off.

KAT

Okay but--

MADDY I'll take care of her.

KAT

Yeah... because someone thinking that they saw her doesn't mean they actually did.

MADDY

I know...

KAT

And don't leave her alone with them. Ever. A couple of big cops hovering over her... I've been there. You'll say almost anything just to get them to back off. (to Ash) You all right with this?

ASH If I was seen, I was seen.

MADDY Do you know where I keep the emergency cell?

KAT

Under your--

HANNA

Mattress.

MADDY

Right. One of you get it. Keep it handy. And I'll call to let you know what's going on.

ASH (to Kat) Bye... KAT Yeah... (hugs her) Ah Jesus, Ash. Please try to be okay. No matter what. ASH (gives her a thumbs up) No matter what. Maddy gently ushers Ash out. HANNA I'll go get the phone. KAT (wiping her eyes) Sure... but we need to talk first. HANNA About what? KAT (to Max) Maybe you should go have that talk with your dad. Get things rolling. Tell him we're gonna back off for awhile. And... you could use a shower. MAX Right. So... KAT (gesture towards door) Just let me know how it goes. MAX Yeah. For sure. He grabs his jacket. MAX (CONT'D) See ya soon. KAT Definitely...

103.

He hugs her. Leaves.

HANNA

What's all that stuff about his dad?

KAT None of your business.

HANNA

As usual. You know, you really have to learn to open up. Even a little would be an improvement. You were right about him needing a shower though. I was gonna have to mention it eventually.

Kat just looks at her.

KAT We can't let Ash take the blame for this.

HANNA What are you talking about?

KAT

I'm talking about what Maddy said. The special situation we're in. The special circumstances... for Ash.

HANNA Which the police and the courts will take into consideration.

KAT

But not enough. There won't be enough "consideration" to help Ash in any real way. If they don't put her in prison she'll wind up a mental ward forever. How's that gonna be okay.

HANNA

But she killed him. She was seen.

KAT

Not actually killing him she wasn't. I could make them think it was someone else.

HANNA

Who?

Kat just looks at her. Hard.

Slowly Hanna gets it.

HANNA (CONT'D)

You fucker!

KAT

Well it makes sense, right. I mean look how Victor treated you. And you have a history of lashing out when you get thrown aside.

HANNA That happened once. Just once.

KAT

No you told me you were just as mad at Victor as you were with the girl you ran down in your daddy's car.

HANNA

No I didn't.

KAT

We had a long conversation about it.

HANNA

No. We did not! And I didn't run her down. I just knocked her over.

KAT

You told me you meant to kill her. That was a big part of the conversation you say we didn't have. And me telling the cops about that conversation might be enough to get them to--

HANNA

What are you doing?

KAT

I'm going to the police to tell them what actually happened.

HANNA Oh come on. They're not going to --KAT I'm going to tell them it was me. HANNA (looks at her) You. You did it? KAT That's what I'll say. HANNA So you didn't do it. KAT Ash was in the neighbourhood. I saw her when I was waiting in the alley near Victor's car. HANNA Waiting to kill him. You'll say you were waiting to kill him. KAT Yeah... HANNA Why? KAT I'm still working on that. HANNA I mean why are you doing this? KAT Because Ash won't get through it. HANNA She killed him, Kat. KAT Well someone was gonna have to pay for what she's been through. If it had to be a man who had almost no compassion left in him, big

motherfucking deal.

HANNA

And you're willing to pay the price. Prison for life maybe.

KAT Better me that her.

HANNA Why? Why better you?

KAT

Because I'm gonna wind up there anyway. You've told me that a hundred times, Hanna.

HANNA Yeah... but that was before...

KAT

Before what? Max? You think I'm gonna let him attach himself to me, so I can take him down too.

HANNA

So this is serious. You're really going to try to pull this off. Well what was all that about trying to lay it on me?

KAT That's something I'll still do if you don't shut up about all your "problems" for awhile and concentrate on helping Ash when she comes back.

HANNA

Helping her how?

KAT

By caring about her as much as you care about yourself. It's gonna be hard for you at first, but if you keep at it...

HANNA What? I could become a better person? Jesus. You're such an idiot. KAT I've gotta go pack my tooth brush.

HANNA

No really. Are you high or something? You are, aren't you. You're fucking out of it. Just go lie down and get yourself straight, for chrissake!

Kat leaves.

HANNA (CONT'D) "It was me, Officer. I did it" "No actually it was her. The fat one"... I mean really... Idiot!

Blackout.

SCENE 9 Kat comes down and starts out just as Maddy returns MADDY Where you going? KAT For a walk. How's Ash? MADDY She's being... processed. KAT Processed. Right. Well I'll see you in a--HANNA (exits kitchen) Tell her. KAT Hanna. HANNA Tell her. You know, just to see what she thinks about the idea. MADDY What idea? HANNA She's off to confess to killing Victor. MADDY Ash killed Victor. HANNA No. Kat did. Ask her how she did it. Did she use a rock, a stick... (to Kat) I bet the cops know what it was. So you better get that one right. MADDY Kat. Look at me.

Kat obeys.

MADDY (CONT'D) There are now two other witness who saw Ash leaving that alley. You can't help her.

Kat just looks at her. Then at Hanna.

MADDY (CONT'D) She'll be all right.

KAT

Will she?

MADDY

Well she didn't have control of herself, and when they find that out--

KAT It won't matter. They'll still have to put her away somewhere. (she might be crying) And then she'll be gone... again...

Maddy sits on the couch. Gestures to Kat.

MADDY

Come here.

Kat sits beside Maddy.

KAT Putting her in a mental hospital. That's like just putting her on a shelf somewhere.

HANNA

She's right.

MADDY Hanna, don't.

HANNA

But she's right. You think I like admitting she's right? They did that to me when I broke down. They put me in a room and drugged me. Okay I was pretty hysterical because I'd just tried to run someone I loved over with a car. But... (MORE)

111.

HANNA (CONT'D)

well that's what they did until they were sure I wasn't going to... hurt myself.

KAT

(to Maddy) You think they'll ever be sure abut Ash?

MADDY

They'll do their best to move her along... make her better.

KAT

That won't happen. At least here with us she had her moments, lots of times when she was just getting on with it, right. Feeding rodents. Sharing her food with them.

HANNA And thinking about killing someone.

KAT

No way. (to Maddy) You think that? That she planned it?

MADDY

No I think something just happened between them. Maybe Victor said something, did something...

KAT When can we visit her?

MADDY

I don't know. Probably not for awhile. It depends on where she winds up, where we're all going to be. I mean do you have any idea where you're going.

KAT

Not really.

MADDY

And if I lose this job I might have to move to another city for work. HANNA

They can't let you go. I need you.

MADDY

You do?

HANNA

Well I need somebody. And I'm getting used to you, so...

KAT

She's right. They can't fire you just because you're seeing a shrink.

MADDY

A shrink who warned the police that I might be about to harm someone.

HANNA

Harm who?

KAT

Victor (to Maddy) Why? What was he doing to *you*?

MADDY

Nothing. It's what I was sure he was doing to all of you. I had a hard time believing it for awhile because when I came here ... just out of detention myself, he was pretty wonderful. Protective. Kind. So is that what can happen? You lose respect for the people who come to you for help. They all start to look basically the same to you. Bad girls who'd done bad things and didn't give a damn about the consequences. So why should you? Did he think like that. Maybe it's hard after awhile, even for people who should know better, not to. Bad girls. Worthless girls. Well worthless except for what pleasure they can offer you. But Ash was different, right. Ash wasn't having anymore of that. Not when she was in that scary place in her head. (MORE)

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MADDY (CONT'D)

And I'm sure that's where she was when she bashed in Victor's skull... I told Muncie about what I thought Victor was up to. He said he didn't believe it. But I think it was just too much for him to deal with. So I... started thinking abut putting an end to it myself.

KAT

How?

MADDY

Well I didn't think going through normal channels was going to work. It started as just a thought... or maybe even a wish.

HANNA

What?

KAT The idea of killing Victor.

MADDY

An idea that wouldn't go away. So... I started talking to my therapist about it. I guess I talked about it enough for him to think I was actually going to do it.

HANNA

Were you?

MADDY

I'm not sure. When I was your age and I needed to get high, I did a lot of things to make that happen. Never killed anyone, but I could have. The fact that I was even thinking about doing it now, I think that means there's still a lot of that fucked up girl inside me. Oh well, who said it was going to be easy. (off their looks) Getting myself together.

(to Kat) Why not go spend some time with the family you just found out about? HANNA They sound pretty weird from what Max told me. (to Kat) I wouldn't go anywhere near them if I were you.

KAT Thanks for the advice.

HANNA (to Maddy) I think she should stay here. You can tell them she lied about her age and that she's still eligible, to live here.

KAT You want me to stay?

HANNA Well I'm used to you. (off Maddy) Like I'm used to her. You're people who are ... here. We're together. Like all the time. And I'm okay with Max visiting when he wants ... (to Maddy) Plus you should fight to stay with us. Because ... why not? You didn't actually kill him. You just talked about it. I mean we all want to kill someone sometimes. (off Kat) We want to kill each other maybe three or four times a day. (to Kat) Right?

KAT

At least.

Maddy looks at them. Almost smiles.
